Requirements: Working Walk, Free Walk, Working Trot

Purpose: To introduce introductory level dressage concepts and the dressage ring to early elementary-aged youth, incorporating fun trail-style obstacles. Key concepts, as expected on Intro Level Dressage Tests, will include straightness, willingness from the horse, consistency of the gaits (steady tempo), riders' correct equitation (steady hands, still legs, and balanced seat).

3.	Between I and R , half circle around barrel while retrieving object from top of barrel.		
4.	Between R and B , working trot.

6.	P Place object on barrel.		
7.	F Working trot.		
8.	Between F and K , trot over poles.		
9.	K Free walk.		
10.	V Turn right to complete half circle around barrel, returning to hoof track.		
11.	E Working walk.		
12.	Between S and H , weave cones.		
13.	C Halt, Salute.
